For purposes of security and prevention of electrical accidents, the Exhibiting Company

DECLARES

Electrical wiring

- 1) That the electrical wiring and components to be installed on its stand are designed in conformity with current EC regulations and Ministerial Decree 37 dated 27 January 2008 and subsequent amendments;
2) That when requesting connection to the electricity supply will hand over a copy of the "DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY OF THE WELL-INSTALLED WIRING" written on the appropriate form approved by the ministerial decree dated 20 February 1992 (see form B/2).
3) Declare that the wiring will be carried out by a Company in possession of the technical-professional requirements and relevant registration at the Chamber of Commerce and/or the Crafts Industry Guilds and qualified for the installation of civil and industrial electric wiring systems.

If the wiring is carried out by an Italian company, the company itself must complete the form B/2 "Declaration of compliance of electric wiring".

If the electric wiring is carried out by a foreign company, the Exhibitor must present IMM Carrara Spa with the plan for the electric wiring which must be certified by a qualified electrician in accordance with the IEC-CENELEC-CEI regulations, with all expenses borne by the Exhibitor.

Stand fittings

- 1) The materials used shall be correctly installed and/or inflammable paints applied in compliance with the type standards and/or prescribed certifications for fire reaction (Art. 10 of M.D dated 26 June 1984);
2) the average fire load per square metre on the stand, considering both the fitting materials and the exhibited materials, according to the calculations criteria set out in the Ministerial Decree no. 74 dated 9/3/2007 and subsequent amendments and integrations with maximum limit of 900 MJ for each booth and/or not more than 56 MJ/sqm;
3) the "DECLARATION OF THE CORRECT INSTALLATION OF THE FITTING MATERIALS " shall be sent to IMM Carrara Spa written on the appropriate form approved by Ministerial Decree dated 4 May 1998;
4) a sufficient number of extinguishers will be positioned on the stand according to the exhibition surface area occupied, with a minimum of n°1 6 kg powder extinguisher every 16 sqm.

The Exhibitor relieves IMM Carrara Spa, the Organiser, the Secretariat, the Technical Department and any third parties involved in any way in the exhibition of all responsibility, formally waiving the submission of any request for compensation and/or claims to IMM Carrara Spa, the Organiser, the Secretariat and the same third parties for any damage that may occur to persons or things, in particular regarding the electrical wiring and stand fittings.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE MATERIALS TO BE USED FOR STAND FITTINGS

In order to ensure the greatest possible efficiency in terms of the overall safety conditions of the exhibition centre, Exhibitors shall observe the fire prevention laws and ensure that they are observed by the stand fitters. In any case the materials used for the fittings must meet the following requirements:

- Walls, floors, structures and interior finishings: Class 1 or class 2, non-flammable materials;
- Class 1 drapery and ceilings.

The use of plastic materials, even in panels, expanded sheets (e.g. polystyrene foam) other than class 1 is prohibited; the use of small quantities for elements of decoration is admitted.

The use of non-fireproofed synthetic fibre materials, varnishes, paints, glues other than class 1 or class 2, reed matting, mats, wickerwork, curtains made of thin wooden slats or analogous materials is also prohibited.

Depending on the materials used, the following documents must be produced:

• Incombustible material

Wherever incombustible materials are used, the Exhibitor must hand in a written statement certifying the use of the indicated material in preparing the stand.

• Class 1 and/or 2 Materials

Wherever class 1 or class 2 materials are used, the Exhibitor must hand in:

- the standard act and related test report on the material issued by the Ministero degli Interni-Direzione Generale della Protezione Civile Centro Studi ed Esperienza Antincendio (Home Office-Head office of Civil Defence, Centre for Fire Prevention research and Experience) (Roma Capannelle) or by legally recognised Bodies and Laboratories; or-special certification (art. 10 Ministerial Decree dated 26.6.84) issued by authorised laboratories.

• Materials fire resistant in origin

Wherever materials fire resistant in origin are used, the Exhibitor must hand in:

- the type approval and related test report on the material issued by the Ministero degli Interni-Direzione Generale della Protezione Civile Centro Studi ed Esperienza Antincendio (Home Office-Head office of Civil Defence, Centre for Fire Prevention research and Experience) (Roma-Capannelle) or by legally recognised Bodies and Laboratories.

The approved materials must bear a mark showing their conformity with the approved prototype.

If it is not possible to put the mark on the material the manufacturer must certify its conformity with the appropriate certificate.

All sellers must, under his/her own civil and criminal responsibility, declare that the sold material comes with a declaration of conformity specifying the type approval details.

• Fire-proofed materials

Wherever fire-proofed materials are used, the Exhibitor must hand in the Fire-proofing certificate written by who actually carried out the protective treatment. The certificate must state:

- a) the Exhibitor's company name, the hall number and stand number;
- b) the list of materials that have been fire-proofed;
- c) the date of fire-proofing treatment (no longer than 6 months before the beginning of the exhibition);
- d) the treated surface;
- e) the main characteristics of the product used: type approval for the substances applied issued by the Home Office or "special" certification (art. 10 M.D. 26.6.84);
- f) the warranty of correct execution by who actually carried out the fire-proofing treatment and the consequent commitment to relieving IMM Carrara Spa, the Organiser, the Secretariat, the Technical Department and any third parties involved in any way in the exhibition of all responsibility, formally waiving the submission of any request for compensation and/or claims to IMM Carrara Spa, the Organiser, the Secretariat and the same third parties for any damage that may occur to persons or things belonging to third parties and compensating for any damage suffered directly by IMM Carrara Spa.

The products used for fire-proofing must be type approved by the Ministero degli Interni-Direzione Generale della Protezione Civile Centro Studi ed Esperienza Antincendio (Home Office- Head office of Civil Defence, Centre for Fire Prevention research and Experience) (Roma-Capannelle) or by legally recognised Bodies and Laboratories.

WARNING

It should be noted that fire-proofing treatment carried out on fabrics, if carried out correctly, can keep its protective characteristics, indicated by the supplier of the product, for a maximum period of 6 months; this provided that:

- after its use the treated fabric is stored and conserved in a dry place;
- during the aforementioned 6 months the treated fabric is not washed, ironed or even beaten with a carpet beater or similar. There are fabrics available on the market that are fire-resistant as they are. These materials must have passed the fire reaction tests according to regulations laid out in the Ministerial Circular n°.12 dated 17/5/80 and M.D. 26/6/84. IMM Carrara Spa, may, at its indisputable discretion, through a specific body or its staff, take samples of the product used for the protective treatment from the materials used for the preparation of the stand. Failure to comply to these regulations and the relevant regulations set out in the Participation Regulations entitles IMM Carrara Spa to take precautionary measures against any company that does not fully comply with the fire regulations. Should additional measures to the general safety conditions be made, this may lead to charging the corresponding expenses calculated at no less than euro 300,00/module or to the injunction for the partial or total dismantling of the stand and the declaration its unsuitability.

FAILURE TO OBSERVE THE SAFETY REGULATIONS MAY LEAD TO REPORTING TO THE LEGAL AUTHORITIES.

All exhibitors must keep a 6 kg powder fire extinguisher for fire class 13 A 89 B-C approved in compliance with M.D. dated 20/12/82 placed according to its centre of gravity on the stand where it can be seen and is ready for use.
